# Urban Pinnacle® Oak



**Height: 55'**



**Spread: 25'**

**Narrow and upright with a strong central leader, this cultivar also features attractive glossy foliage and resistance to both mildew and anthracnose. About ½" in diameter, the acorns are extremely small for a bur oak, making it a more suitable tree for landscape and street use.**

# Starlite Crabapple



Height: 25'



Spread: 15'

A new selection of flowering crabapple for the northern plains. Starlite® offers dark-green, glossy, disease-resistant foliage that is an improvement over Spring Snow. The white flowers are evident in mid-May followed by candy-like, retained fruit.

# Heritage® Oak



Height: 50'



Spread: 40'

Handsome dark green foliage, a broadly pyramidal form, and mildew resistance combine to make this an excellent street tree. An English x bur oak hybrid, it has better cold tolerance than English oak.

# Skyline® Honeylocust



Height: 45'



Spread: 35'

The most widely used Honey Locust cultivar. Its upright spreading branch angles, well behaved form and environmental tolerance make Skyline® an ideal street tree in many situations.

# Espresso™ Kentucky Coffee Tree



Height: 50'



Spread: 35'

Large, frond-like, doubly compound leaves form a canopy of dappled shade that gives this city-tough tree an airy, tropical feel. The arching branches of this seedless selection present an elm-like shape as the tree matures. Good tolerance of heat, drought, cold and alkaline soils.

# Exclamation!® Planetree



Height: 55'



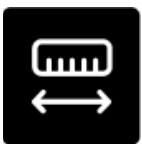
Spread: 35'

Near-perfect symmetry commands attention in any landscape. A carefree performer on city streets, it is urban tolerant, anthracnose resistant, and moderately resistant to powdery mildew. A moderate growth rate, light-fruited habit and resistance to frost cracking are additional reasons to plant this adaptable shade tree.

# State Street® Maple



Height: 50'



Spread: 35'

**This Chicagoland Grows® introduction has shown excellent heat, drought, and alkaline soil tolerance. STATE STREET™ Miyabe's maple has thick, five-lobed, attractive, medium to dark green leaves that remain long into fall, then rapidly change to a pale golden-yellow fall color. It is more branched than other maple varieties which makes it a great shade tree.**

# Redpointe® Maple



Height: 45'



Spread: 30'

**Brilliant red fall color plus upright, broadly pyramidal form make this Schmidt introduction a standout. The refined form and foliage of the best *Acer rubrum* cultivars combine the faster growth rate normally found in *Acer x freemanii*. A straight and dominant central leader results in strong branch angles that make it easier to grow.**

# Cumulus Serviceberry



Height: 25'



Spread: 15'

**Cumulus is 20 to 30 feet high and 15 to 20 feet wide; upright-oval form; flowers abundantly in spring; yellow to orange-red fall color.**

# American Dream® Oak



Height: 50'



Spread: 40'

**Vigorous growing and broadly pyramidal with excellent density, this tree shines with bright green, glossy foliage. Selected for strong resistance to anthracnose and powdery mildew, the broad, handsome leaves turn yellow and then tawny brown as they hold into early winter.**
